Focusing on society, economics, and culture, Professor Elm considers the transformation of the later Roman empire into a Christian one. This lecture derives from her forthcoming book, *The Emperors' Eunuch: Civil War, Queer Masculinities, and Imperial Representation in the Early Theodosian Age.*
